Walt Brooks | Vaccine Passport Amendments Among other provisions relating to “vaccine passports,” prohibits an employer from requiring vaccination or proof of vaccination (against any illness). | <u>H.B. 63</u> | Rep. Jon Hawkins | COVID-19 Vaccine Exemptions Requires an employer to relieve an employee or prospective employee of a COVID-19 vaccination mandate if the employee or prospective employee submits a physician’s note stating that the employee or prospective employee was previously infected by COVID-19.
