Overview: The three part contracting training series in partnership with Community Link Consulting will allow you to gain more knowledge and confidence to tackle the contracting environment with payers working towards enhanced reimbursement for services and prepare for future reimbursement strategies as the health care industry evolves. Here is an overview of each part:

Part 1: Let's start with the basics. This first presentation will focus on defining terms, reviewing what contracting options FQHCs have available, and discuss the flow of funds.

Part 2: Building upon the basics in presentation 1, we will go through the contracting process, specifically the types of contracts, who should be involved, and how to handle the negotiations.

Part 3: This final presentation will be focused on value based reimbursement. We will review possible value based models and share examples of what we have seen around the country.

AUCH will be conducting interviews with five key payers/stakeholders:

Molina, Aledade, SelectHealth, the U, and Regence Blue Cross.

The interviews should help to assess the current climate and plans for Value Based Care Contracts. Results garnered from these interviews will be presented in the May 6, 2021 Payment Reform Work Group.

Value Based Care Work Group

The Value Based Care work group will convene on 4/9/2021 to discuss the health center value equation, and potentially a few other items in preparation for our May Payment Reform Work Group meetings. AUCH determined the specific value-based readiness assessment with a few question modifications and that will be presented at the May 20th Payment Reform Work Group for feedback. The readiness assessment will likely open in June 2021.

A Payment Reform Summit is being planned for November.

It is our hope this will be held in person, if that is not realistic by this time it will be held virtually.

We plan to bring payers involved in the stakeholder interviews to participate in this Summit. More to come.

Value and Impact Assessment

AUCH has funding to pay for "Value and Impact Assessments" previously known as "EIA's" for each of the health centers.

COVID Financial Impact on Operations

Update: In looking at the statewide aggregate of Financial losses versus expenses against COVID Supplemental funding, UT is showing a surplus, so we are re-evaluating the story told.

Change in Scope:

AUCH met with Medicaid in December.

AUCH plans to continue conversations with Medicaid in March.
