

Purpose

The purpose of this project is to secure agreements with Federally Qualified Health Centers (Vendor) as defined by the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA), to provide access to therapeutic medications for the treatment of and vaccination against COVID-19 to uninsured individuals in Utah at the conclusion of the Federal Public Health Emergency (PHE).

Vision

To provide state-directed opportunities for equitable access to diagnosis, treatment, and preventive services for COVID-19 infection for those that are uninsured in Utah through partnerships with strategically identified partners.

Time Frame

Effective for at least six months from the official end date of the Public Health Emergency (PHE), or until funds are exhausted.

Objectives

- Provide timely and equitable access to COVID-19 therapeutic medications for qualifying individuals, through appropriate providers and in accordance with EUAs;
- Provide access to COVID-19 therapeutics to uninsured individuals through Community Health Centers (CHCs);
- Reduce the added financial burden on CHCs serving the highest number of uninsured patients by providing reimbursement for treatment costs and the administration fee for COVID-19 vaccine;
- Maintain equitable access to COVID-19 vaccination;
- Ensure qualifying individuals are screened for Medicaid or CHIP coverage;
- Ensure that the state is utilizing its full allocation of COVID-19 therapeutics efficiently and effectively; and
- Strict adherence to state and federal reporting requirements.
